ITINERARY IN BRIEF

TOUR HIGHLIGHTS

Days 1-4: November 5-8, 2018 Depart U.S./Cairo ➤ Arrive in the Egyptian capital, where your touring includes the acclaimed Egyptian Museum; the Citadel of Saladin; and the open-air museum at nearby Memphis, Egypt's first capital. Continue on to the necropolis of Sakkara then to the astounding Pyramids of Giza and the Sphinx guarding them – true wonders of antiquity.

Days 5-7: November 9-11, 2018 Abu Simbel/Lake Nasser Cruise ➤ Fly to Aswan and take a motorcoach to Abu Simbel, where you board your Lake Nasser cruise ship. Visit the dramatic Abu Simbel complex with its temples and statues of Ramses II and his wife Nefertari, and enjoy an evening sound-and-light show. Sail to Kasr Ibrim, the last remaining Nubian settlement, then the Temple of Amada, followed by Wadi el-Seboua with its striking Valley of the Lions.

Days 8-11: November 12-15, 2018Nile Cruise

Disembark in Aswan where you visit Kalabsha Temple, the largest Nubian temple, and tour the massive Aswan High Dam. Board your Nile cruise ship and visit the Temples of Philae on Agilkia Island. Sail aboard *feluccas*, replicas of ancient Nile sailboats. Visit the ancient trading town of Kom Ombo, and Edfu's Temple of Horus, Egypt's best-preserved temple. Enjoy a traditional belly dancing performance during your final cruise to Luxor, "the world's greatest open air museum." Explore Luxor's West Bank, site of the haunting Valley of the Kings and the Valley of the Queens. See the massive Colossi of Memnon. Tour Luxor's East Bank, home of splendid Karnak temple and Luxor Temple with its famed obelisk.

Days 12-14: November 16-18, 2018 Luxor/Cairo

➤ Disembark your Nile ship and see the Luxor Museum's notable relics. Fly to Cairo, where you visit the lively Khan el-Khalili bazaar and encounter Old Cairo, the richly historic district where early capital cities once stood.

Day 15: November 19, 2018 Depart Cairo for U.S. Early this morning, transfer to the airport for your return flight to the U.S.
